July 1, 2016 – June 30, 2017

CRITERIA TO AWARD COLLEGE CREDIT

The following criteria will be used to award college credit for identified high school courses:

1. Grade of B or higher in the course, &;
2. A scaled score of A on the CTE post assessment (either provided by NC DPI or an approved third party), &;
3. Students must enroll at Wake Tech within two years of their high school graduation date.
